- **The Pongo Fund:**
provides high-quality pet food for thousands of hungry dogs, cats and horses each year.
You must call and leave a message or email at least 7 days in advance if your first time. They need this time to schedule your visit and go over paperwork. Your call or email must include your name, address (if available), phone number or email, and your specific reason for reaching out to The Pongo Fund. If you fail to include this information outlined here, they may not be able to respond. Do not send any attachments or photos. They respond as quickly as they can. Be sure to add their number to your contacts so you can
